The Effingham County United Methodist Campground is a testament to the faith and perseverance by local Methodists throughout the years in an effort to create a wonderful location to worship God with others.



The Lee Family moved to Nicaragua in 2012 following the call God placed on their lives to share His love and truth of salvation with indigenous Miskito people. They live in a remote village of Krinkrin in the jungle of Nicaragua, where the only access is by boat five to six hours upriver from where the road ends. They reach out to many villages along the Coco River and the surrounding area.

MISSION: Support children and youth in the Moskitia area of Honduras

Send Hope provides a safe loving home physically disabled, abused, neglected, malnourished and orphaned children & youth. They support and assist more than 1000 children in remote areas through the HOUSE OF HOPE children's home.

Send Hope serves the community through facilitating medical surgeries, meeting medical needs, distributing

school supplies and supporting primary education at Escuela Casa Esperanza (School House of Hope).

Two 40 Ft. containers are packed with donated staple food each year costing Send Hope more than \$7000 per container. The food is donated by companies and churches.

Springfield Oaks Church gives financial support for the ministry in Moskitia, Honduras, Send Hope and Mission On The Move have worked together since 1994 on the Moskitia coast of Honduras. Dr. Tom Brian, a dentist from Allen, TX, helped the Shearouses lead mission teams from the our church to work with the indigenous people in remote areas. Teams drilled wells for clean water, ministered to the people spiritually, and led medical teams to help Dr. Tom Brian care for their physical needs.
