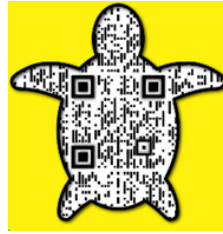
There will be NO Kingdom Kids on December 8th due to the Children's play and December 15th due to the Adult Cantata.

2025 Greeter Ministry

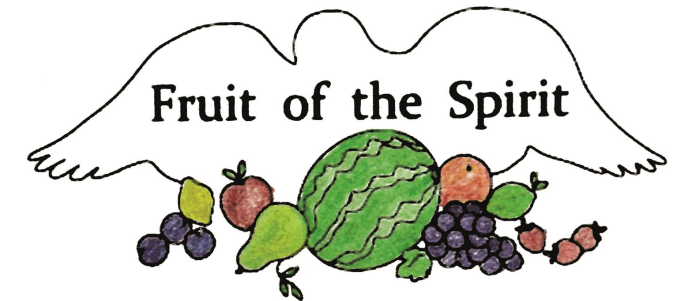
